HERE COMES GOD'S KINGDOM!

After John was arrested, Jesus came into Galilee announcing God's good news, saying "Now is the time! Here comes God's kingdom! Change your hearts and lives, and trust this good news!" Mark 1:14-15

At home, we are reading Mark's Gospel as a family using a devotional written for children, *Best News Ever: Your 100-Day Guide to the Gospel of Mark* by Chris Morphew. One of the best books we've read together, we are all learning and growing. The book focuses on just a few verses a day and, as we progress through the Gospel, we are learning, with the disciples, more and more about who Jesus is, how He defies their expectations of the promised Messiah, and the nature of His kingdom.

"Jesus gives orders to storms, and they obey. He feeds huge crowds from almost nothing. He claims to forgive sins – which would be completely outrageous, except that then he backs up that claim by healing the sick and even raising the dead. He talks constantly abut God's kingdom, but he doesn't seem to just be announcing it, like John did. It's as if he's saying he's actually here to bring the kingdom." p.124

In encounter after encounter, we see Jesus' rule and authority over sin, evil, death and suffering: a paralysed man, someone with a damaged arm, a man overwhelmed by evil spirits, a little girl who has died, an impoverished woman who has been bleeding for years, and others who cannot see or hear BUT all completely transformed for good because of a meeting with Jesus, the King of Kings.

We still live in a world where there is sin, evil, death and suffering, and sadly, at New Hope, we are familiar with all of these. We see the effects of abuse, trauma, violence, and addiction on a day-to-day basis. But yet, we can say as Jesus did: Here comes God's kingdom!

Please pray this year for New Hope service users to encounter Jesus, just where they are, whatever their needs, whatever their sorrows, whatever their past, whatever their fears. Please pray for people to trust Jesus' good news and to change their hearts. Please pray for God's kingdom to come more and more at New Hope. We long to see more freedom, more joy, more peace, more truth, more hope, more faith and more Jesus!
